- ASLC raised approximately \$2,000 for the Bowie CROP walk. Grand totals for the walk are not yet available from St. Matthew's.
- Linda Baine, JoAnn Lohsen and I hosted the county's Warm Nights Orientation Session on Tuesday, October 1st. More than 50 persons attended. CCSI is expanding its efforts to identify the locations of homeless campsites in the county in order to send out CCSI teams to talk with the occupants and offer assistance to them. Churches were offered an invitation to join the scouting teams and I have contacted the coordinator to get more information to see how we might become involved.
- Linda, JoAnn and I met Wednesday, October 9th, to begin planning for our week of Warm Nights, November 17-24th. Next Sunday, after each service, we will begin to solicit volunteers to assist with set-up, meals, hosting, etc. We will again be taking socks donations and quarters for laundry night.
- Dave Conrad and I are planning a "God's Work. Our Hands." follow-up door-to-door communication with our Glen Allen neighbors, thanking them for their contributions to the Food Pantry, inviting them to join us in our continued support of the pantry, especially during our holiday collections, and inviting them to get to know their ASLC neighbors by attending our upcoming Oktoberfest. They will be asked to call the church if they plan to attend so we can know numbers.
