Youth Ministry Mission:

Key Elements for ASLC Youth Ministry

- ✓ Build relationships through faith practices, fellowship and service
- ✓ Encourage parental and congregational support and participation
- ✓ Outreach to surrounding community through service and fellowship activities
- ✓ A balance of events for youth only, youth plus family, youth plus congregation, youth plus our community

Responsibilities

- Coordinate and host bi-weekly fellowship and disciple session as a means to nurture and mentor youth as well as build a sense of community among them
- Coordinate with parents for all volunteer and support needs of youth group on a regular basis
- Plan and implement service and/or mission projects to help the youth grow as they learn to serve others (approx. once a month)
- Plan and coordinate local and regional camps, conferences, retreats and trips to deepen the youth's relationship with Jesus and each other
- Provide a monthly report to the church council liaison
- Submit an Annual Report to the congregation at the end of each year and work with council liaison to create spending plan each year.

Qualifications for a Youth Minister Position

Person reports directly to – Pastor and Church Council

- Ideal candidate will have either a degree or applicable experience with youth ministry (2-5 years working with youth ages 12 to 18)
- Lead a life of faith
- Excellent leadership, organizational, and communication skills
- Valid driver's license
- Successfully complete background and reference check.

Hourly Employee

Youth Group Leader is allotted 20 hours each month with an hourly rate of \$20/hour.
